 - (d) the right to have the assistance of a lawyer at all stages of the proceedings,
 - (e) also the right to take the witness stand at my sole option, and the District Attorney cannot force me to testify against myself,
 - (f) if I do not take the witness stand, I understand the jury will be told that this may not be held against me, or will be told nothing, at my option.

6. I also understand that if I plead GUILTY NO CONTEST, the Court may impose the same punishment as if I had pleaded Not Guilty, stood trial and been convicted.

7. I know that the Crime Seriousness Rating for this (these) crime(s) is 1-2. I believe my Criminal History Scale is a I.

8. I know that if I plead GUILTY NO CONTEST to this charge (these charges), the maximum possible sentence is 1 years imprisonment with a possible minimum sentence of up to — years, and/or a fine of \$5,000. I know also that under sentencing guidelines my presumptive sentence is 18M. I know however that the Court could depart from that presumptive sentence and impose a greater sentence. I know further that the sentence is up to the Court only and in the event the District Attorney makes any recommendation, the Court is not bound to accept or follow it.


