1. That Curtis M. Jacobsen was convicted of the Class A misdemeanor of Sexual Abuse in the 3rd Degree in Washington County Case #C970290CR on April 30, 1997;
2. That more than 10 years have elapsed since termination of his supervision;
3. That Curtis M. Jacobsen does not have any other criminal convictions;
4. That Curtis M. Jacobsen has successfully completed sex offender treatment;
